The faculty positions will be on the tenure track with university year appointments starting Sep. 1, 2020, or Jan. 1, 2021.

Candidates must have the following qualifications:

- A PhD, MD, or other terminal degree
- Evidence of superlative scientific accomplishment and scholarly promise
- Depending on field, evidence of teaching excellence

Primary school and departmental affiliation(s) will be determined by the applicant's qualifications and preferences, and by relevance of the applicant's research program to departmental initiatives and themes.
