- From the Vanguard Hotel to BSRB, cross Glen Avenue, walk East along Ann Street to Zina Pitcher Place. Cross Ann Street and enter the doors to the BSRB on the Northeast corner of the building. Please note that these are the only doors of the BSRB that are unlocked.
- From the BSRB to Palmer Commons, exit the BSRB in the Northeast corner, cross Zina Pitcher place, turn right and walk along the sidewalk and up the slight ramp, crossing over Washtenaw Avenue to Palmer Commons straight ahead. Enter the building and take the stairs or elevator to the 4th Floor, Great Lakes Room

Parking

Visitor parking is available in a number of locations across campus using the [AIMS Mobile Pay \(AMP\) System](#), as well as the [Palmer Structure](#) with pay-in-lane machines. Parking fees are \$2.50 per hour. The maximum hours of use and enforcement hours, which vary by location, are posted in the location listings. Motorcycles and mopeds are also eligible to park in visitor spaces in lots by paying the associated fees. They are not allowed to use structure spaces.
